

**BYLAW NO. 215/2007**  
**“ Bylaw to Amend Bylaw 212/2006”**

**Being a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Silver Beach, in the Province of Alberta,  
To Amend the Boat Lifts and Hoists Bylaw 212/2006**

**PURSUANT TO** provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26-1, 1994 with amendments in force as of March 18, 2004; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Beach desires to enact a Bylaw that amends the Boat Lifts and Hoists Bylaw;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Beach **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Part 1, Item 4 of Bylaw 212/2006 be amended to read as follows:

Where the identity of the owner cannot be determined, the Summer Village of Silver Beach reserves the right to dispose of the property as it sees fit after the property has been held and unclaimed for a period of thirty (30) days in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Government Act.
